WUE Eligible States:

Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming.

Student Instructions/Check List:

- Apply to Colorado Mountain College (*WUE tuition benefits for new students is only available at the Leadville, Steamboat Springs and Spring Valley campuses*)
Complete and return this WUE Participation Form and a copy of a valid WUE state driver's license or State ID card before the deadline to: Central Admission, 802 Grand Ave, Glenwood Springs, CO, 81601 or joinus@coloradomtn.edu ***A limited number of WUE slots will be offered.*
- Submit applicable high school or college transcripts
- Submit ACT/SAT Test Scores

WUE Participation Criteria:

1. New WUE students must submit the online CMC admissions application and supplemental WUE participation form by **July 15th for fall semester, and December 1st for spring semester** (Contact Admissions for **summer semester** deadline).
2. Continuing WUE students, at any campus, must declare their intention to continue at CMC by registering for the next semester during the early registration period (summer excluded).
3. Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.
4. Maintain enrollment with a minimum of 15 credits for each semester you attend (summer semester is a minimum of 6 credit hours).
5. Only available for 100 and 200 level course and associate degree programs.
6. Available to first time freshman transferring less than 15 credits (excluding credit earned while in high school via dual or concurrent enrollment and/or AP and IB credits).
7. Maintain good academic standing with a 2.0 Cumulative GPA or higher.
8. Remain a permanent resident of your home WUE state (maintaining your home state driver's license will be required).
9. Residential campuses have a housing requirement. ([See Living On Campus in Catalog](#))

NOTE: WUE students who do not maintain the minimum credit hours and minimum 2.0 GPA per semester attended will be placed on probation. Students will have one additional semester to maintain minimum credits and increase GPA to 2.0, failure to do so will result in suspension from WUE eligibility and/or Colorado Mountain College.
